Award Guidelines 2019

GOAL

To further the interest of young people in pipe organ performance by offering a stipend toward the cost of attending a POE event (*either* a Pipe Organ Encounter; Pipe Organ Encounter/Advanced or Pipe Organ Encounter/Technical) of the American Guild of Organists.

AWARD

- A. At least one scholarship in the amount of \$400 will be awarded at the discretion of the judges. The award will be remitted to the AGO Chapter sponsoring the POE by the time of the POE.
- B. Scholarship winner will be chosen by the Scholarship Committee, composed of local qualified musicians, as empowered by the Executive Board of the Ann Arbor Chapter of the American Guild of Organists.
- C. Preference will be given to those who have not previously won the award.

OUALIFICATIONS

- A. Applicant must be between the ages of 13 and 18, and must have completed some piano or organ study.
- B. Applicant shall be a resident of southeastern Michigan or be a pupil of an Ann Arbor Chapter member.
- C. Applicant must submit a completed application form and additional letters as described in the application.
- D. Applicant may be requested to perform a representative piece of music for the Scholarship Committee.

AWARD RECIPIENT

- A. All applicants will be notified by letter of the judges' decision.
- B. The winner may be requested to participate in a program sponsored by the Ann Arbor Chapter.
