Qualifications: Candidates should have excellent organ and piano skills. Ability to lead choir rehearsals and chose music appropriate for liturgical seasons. Good communication skills required to coordinate and organize schedule of performing groups and soloists along with the needs of the minister and other staff. Attendance at occasional staff meetings required. Additional responsibilities may include Handbell Director. The organist will be expected to play for special services such as Thanksgiving Eve, Christmas Eve, Ash Wednesday, Maundy Thursday and Good Friday if needed. The organist will be given the opportunity to play for weddings and funerals for additional income if desired. The organist/music director is invited to schedule and hold private music lessons at the church to generate additional income as the church schedule and facilities allow.
